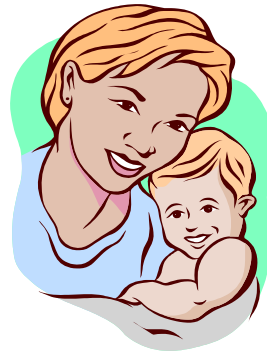
Hope all of our readers are doing well, and are ready for Spring to begin. We all have had enough of this winter weather.

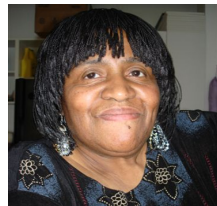
